

Huckabee has enjoyed a two-decade long relationship with Rabbi Pinchus and Esther Hadassah Ciment, directors of Chabad-Lubavitch in his home state of Arkansas. In 1996, Huckabee became the state's first governor to join Chabad's public Chanukah menorah-lighting in Little Rock. He did so again late last year, when he substituted for his daughter, Sarah Huckabee Sanders—the current governor of Arkansas—in lighting the menorah with Chabad of Arkansas on the first night of Chanukah.

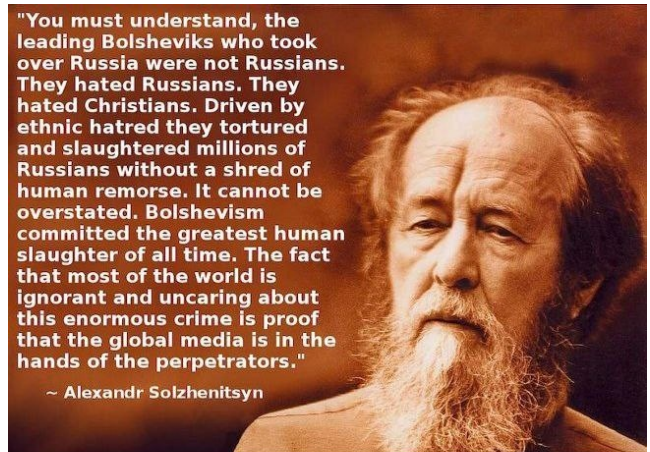
Jews literally rebelled against Hellenization that was brought to Judea.

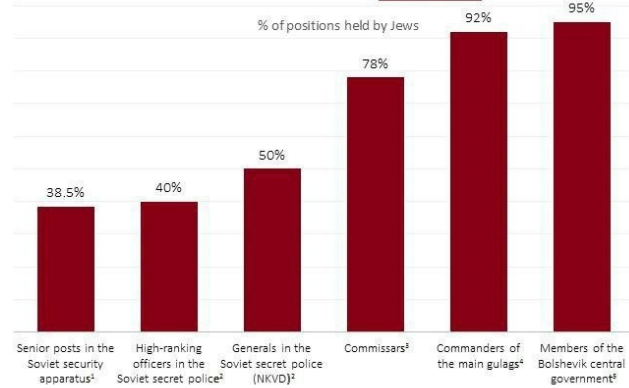
famine that occurred throughout Southern Russia after the Judeo-Soviet takeover of Russia in 1917.

The jews, who wanted to destroy all the Christians in Southern Russia and have more direct control over the collectivized farms, starved out the Christian communities and killed 8 to 12 million Christians. This Genocide was well known among the elites of the world, but wasn't widely published because of jewish control over the press. They owned all the large, international newspapers, including the New York Times, by the late 1800s.

The holodomor occurred from 1932 to 1933. In the larger part of that period, from 1917 through 1935, they had exterminated over 30 million Europeans.
