

## APPENDIX C - JESUS IS KING OF HIS KINGDOM, AS PROPHESED BY THE PROPHETS

1. Genesis 17:15-16: Abraham's offspring through Sarah was to produce kings.
2. Micah 5:2: The king was to be born in Bethlehem (Matt. 2:2).
3. Isaiah 9:6-7: The king was to take the throne of David (Luke 1:32-33).
4. John 1:31: John the Baptist introduces Christ the Messiah to Israel.
5. John 1:49: The Messiah was Israel's king.
6. Matthew 3:1-12: John the Baptist preaches the kingdom of God to Israel.
7. Mark 1:14-15: Jesus preaches the time is fulfilled and that the kingdom of God is here. What time is fulfilled (Dan. 2:44-45; 7:13, 14, 18, 27)?
8. John 3:3-5: Admittance into the kingdom is via the new birth.
9. Matthew 10:7; Luke 10:9: Jesus sends His disciples to preach the kingdom.
10. Matthew 16:19: Jesus gives Peter the keys of the kingdom.
11. Matthew 11:12-13; Luke 16:16: The law and the prophets replaced by Christ's kingdom.
12. Matthew 8:11 -12; Luke 13:29: Old Testament and New Testament saints possess the same kingdom (Col. 1:13; 1 Thess. 2:12; Rev. 1:5-9).

13. Luke 1:18-22: Signs of the Messianic king are fulfilled by Jesus.
14. Luke 4:14: Jesus in Galilee preaches the kingdom as composed of all nations.
15. John 1:14: Jesus is the New Testament tabernacle.
16. John 2:18-19: Jesus is the New Testament temple (Matt. 12:6; Zech. 6:12-15).
17. Mark 11:7-11: Jesus dramatizes the Passover of Himself (1 Cor. 5:7).
18. Hebrews 9:26: Jesus' sacrifice was the end of the ages.
19. Acts 2:1 -36: The last days arrived in Christ and He was resurrected to sit upon the throne of David (Joel 2:28-29; Rom. 15:8-13; Heb. 1:1-13).
20. Matthew 26:26-29: Jesus establishes His New Covenant and fulfills the prophecy of Genesis 12; 15; 17; Exodus 19:6; Isaiah 55:3; Jeremiah 31:31-34; Hebrews 8:6-13; 10:16-18; 13:20.
21. First Peter 2:2-12: All the prophets are fulfilled in Christ (Acts 3:19-26; Luke 24:24-27).
22. Romans 10:4: Jesus terminates the law (John 1:17; Rom. 6:14; 7:1-7; Gal. 3:19).
23. Hebrews 12:28: Christ's kingdom cannot be shaken.
24. John 18:36: If the kingdom did not come with Christ, why did He say it did?
25. Acts 28:25-31: Paul until his death preaches the kingdom of God.
