

APPENDIX E - SCRIPTURE REFERENCES TO THE SECOND COMING

Never once in any of the verses following is it implied that Jesus will come twice. The words: *revelation*, *epiphany* and *parousia* happen at the same time. These three words cannot be separated to imply two or three separate comings of Christ.

1. Matt. 16:27 The Son of Man comes in the glory of His Father.
2. Matt. 25:1-13 The ten virgins. Bridegroom coming for the bride.
3. Luke 12:35-37 Be ready and watching.
4. 1 Cor. 3:13 Everyone's work will be revealed by fire.
5. 1 Cor. 1:7-8 Christians are to eagerly await the revelation of Christ.
6. 1 Cor. 11:26 Communion to believers shows Christ's death until He comes.
7. Col. 3:4-5 When Christ appears [epiphany] we shall appear with Him.
8. Phil. 3:20 Wait for the Savior.
9. Phil. 1:6 He who begun a good work will complete it.
10. Phil. 1:9-10 Be sincere and without offense until the day of Jesus Christ.
11. 1 Cor. 3:13 The day shall declare every man's work.
12. I Thess. 1:9-10 Christians are to wait for His Son from heaven.
13. I Thess. 4:13-18 Christ comes with, as well as for His

- saints.
14. 1 Thess. 5:23 We are to be preserved blameless at the coming parousia.
 15. 2 Thess. 1:4-7 Jesus will be revealed from heaven.
 16. 2 Tim. 4:8 The crown of righteousness to those who love His appearing.
 17. Tit. 2:11-13 Looking for the blessed hope, Christ's glorious appearing.
 18. Heb. 9:27-28 Appointed once to die then the judgment.
 19. James 5:7-8 Be patient until parousia of the Lord.
 20. 1 Pet. 1:13 Believer is to be sober until the revelation of Jesus Christ.
 21. 2 Pet. 3:4 The parousia (v. 4), is the same event as vv. 10, 12, and 13.
 22. 1 John 3:2-3 Believers are to be like Him at His epiphany (Col. 3:4).
 23. 1 John 2:28 We are to abide in Him until He appears.
 24. Jude 14-15 Judgment will be upon the ungodly when Jesus comes.
 25. Rev. 1:7 Every eye shall see Him.
 26. Rev. 2:25 Hold fast until I come.
 27. John 5:28-29 The righteous and wicked are resurrected together.
 28. Matt. 13:36-43 Both tares and wheat are harvested together at the end of the age.
 29. Rev. 11:15-19 Everyone is judged and rewarded at the same time.
